



## TEMPORARY INSURANCE COVER

*The practice of Kyudo here in Australia is as safe as we can make it. Even so, every Australian Kyudo Association Inc. Member is covered by our Public Liability and Personal Accident Insurance policy as part of their annual membership fee. For a limited duration and free-of-charge, the Association will extend this insurance cover to students who wish to try Kyudo as part of a structured Beginners Course or other supervised Kyudo activity.*

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I understand I will be covered under the Australian Kyudo Association Inc. Public Liability and Personal Accident Insurance Policy providing:

- It is only for a maximum period of **four consecutive weeks**, commencing on the date stated below; and,
- The Course or other Kyudo activity is under the direct supervision of an Australian Kyudo Association member who is registered as an Instructor, holding a minimum grade qualification of Shodan (First Dan); and,
- Before commencing any Kyudo session, I will disclose to the Instructor any medical or other condition which might affect my participation, or that of other practitioners; and,
- For safety reasons, I will obey the directions of the Instructor at all times.
